Levels Program

The Levels Program has been developed to give unique opportunities to disciples based on their behaviors and attitudes. This method provides the disciple who understands that the choices they make directly affect the benefits and rewards they receive in life. Those that are not interested in progressing forward with healthy positive choices will not reap the benefits and privileges that accompany those positive choices.

All disciples will enter the program at Level One. The disciple will have an opportunity to move forward to greater rewards and responsibilities or backward to fewer privileges and less responsibility. Life is a learning experience, good choices bring about good consequences and bad choices bring about bad consequences. This is your opportunity to discover God's plan and purpose for your life.

Level One

- Learn 12 designated scriptures.
- Learn the Ten Commandments.
- Write a 2,000-word essay on “Why am I here”?
- Complete 2 Bible study books (‘Purpose Driven Life’ book with 1000 word essay on “Why my life matters”).
- The ability to control the tongue. (Outbursts, swearing, complaining & grumbling)

Level Two

- Learn 20 more designated scriptures, plus recall 5 previous scriptures.
- Learn the New Testament books of the Bible in order.
- Be able to recall the Ten Commandments.
- Write a 2000-word essay on “How I can have positive change take place in my life?”
- Read “Gifted Hands” (Ben Carson Story). Complete 1 Bible Study book.
- Develop exit plan and present to Pastor and Staff.

Level Three

- Learn 20 more designated scriptures, plus recall 10 previous scriptures.
- Learn the Old Testament books of the Bible in order.
- Be able to recall the New Testament books of the Bible and the Ten Commandments.
- Write a 2,000 Word essay on “How am I going to implement my exit plan?”
- Be able to verbally explain the importance of accountability and integrity to leaders and peers.
- Complete 2 Bible study books. (‘Every Man’s Battle & Workbook’, ‘Bait of Satan’ with 1500 word essay each book)

Level Four

- Learn 20 more designated scriptures, plus recall 10 previous scriptures.
- Be able to recall the books of the Bible and the Ten Commandments.
- Write a 2,000 word essay on “My personal Testimony”.
- Present orally your testimony to staff and peers.
- Complete 2 Bible Study books. Read “Frameworks” & “If You Want To Walk On Water You’ve Got To Get Out Of The Boat” with 1500 word essay each book.
- Assist in mentoring other disciples and work in leadership.
- Be able to lead morning devotion.

Arukah House

What we expect from you:

- Please keep in mind that the Arukah House has a family atmosphere and we expect you to treat the home, the people who live there and the leadership of Arukah with respect and love.
- Obey all leaders and Arukah Staff, The Arukah Staff Members are here to help you and will do anything they can to help you overcome your struggles. Following their instruction and lead is very important in helping you transition.
- Attend Bible Studies and fulfill all the Bible assignments required. (Includes Bible workbooks, Bible reading, Scripture memorization, Church services, Prayer time and much, much more.)
- All disciples will be required to do their share of the work around the house, vocational training, and in service projects in the community. We will be giving back by providing services to people of the community. Remember, Arukah is providing this service to you at a minimal cost, but it does cost to provide this house and we thank you for doing your share to make this a great experience for you, other members of the house, and our staff.

All disciples will be expected to obey the House Rules:

1. No Weapons, Drugs, Alcohol or Tobacco Products of any kind will be tolerated at the Arukah House or at any time while you are a resident here.
2. No sexual contact of any kind will be permitted and any word of such activity will bring immediate dismissal from the house. No pornography. Modest and appropriate dress is required at all times.
3. All clothing and personal items must fit neatly in assigned closets and dressers. Each person is responsible for keeping their own living area neat and clean.
4. Appropriate clothing must be worn at all times.
 - a. Shirts and shoes except in your own sleeping area.
 - b. No clothing promoting the usage of any kind. (This includes drugs, alcohol, secular music, tobacco, sex, etc.)
 - c. No sagging pants or shorts.
5. No secular (non-Christian books or newspapers allowed unless approved by Arukah staff.
6. Residents are not allowed in any bedroom but their own.
7. Bed time is at 10:00pm every night except Friday and Saturday at 11:00pm.
8. Daily hygiene is required. This includes showers and shaving. If you have a beard you will need to keep it maintained. Everyone is to shower on a daily basis.
9. Residents must attend all classes, groups, meetings, and church as set forth by the Ministry.
10. No Foul Language is permitted.
11. At all levels, all phone calls, visitors, and Visitation/Day Passes must be arranged and approved by Arukah Staff.
12. No new romantic relationships with members of the opposite or same sex.
13. Fighting or Threats to any other member of this house will be terms for dismissal. This also includes wrestling and horse play.

14. Do not romance the past with glorifying talk about your addictions, relationships, or prison. Seek the Kingdom of God first (Matthew 6:33)
15. Everyone's is to remain on house premise unless a pass has been issued.
16. Having a cell phone is a privilege.
17. As a preventive measure anything not discussed in these rules, should first be approved by the Ministry
18. Let's commit ourselves to a higher standard- God's way of love, responsibility, truth, and grace.

Job Vocational Program

- All men will actively participate in the Job Vocational Program. Currently we receive donated items from vendors and we sell them online and sales. The revenue from sales helps provide for you stay at the Arukah House. Participation is not an option and is crucial in helping to transition back into the workforce and into life. If you choose not to participate in the Job Vocational Program you choose to leave the Arukah Program.
- Job Vocational Program can range from the Arukah Shop, House Chores, Trade Vocational Program, Life Skills Classes or other Arukah business.
- You will also be meeting with an advocate that will help you with job search, resume writing, interview skills, and budgeting. Part of the job vocational training is following the advocates lead and doing the assignments they give you.

Privileges

(All levels are at the individuals own pace)

Level One

1. Privileges are limited. (May be changed depending on life circumstances.)

Level Two

1. Participate in Visitation Day (Saturday 12-5 p.m.).
2. Ability to make one phone call per day after 30 day blackout (10 minutes maximum.).
3. Ability to participate in some church activities as approved by the Pastoral Staff.

Level Three

1. Act as Team Leader
2. Participate in more church activities as approved by Pastoral Staff.
3. Receive Day Passes

Level Four

1. Act as a House Leader
2. Ability to participate in church ministries.
3. Ability to act as a Work Crew Leader.

Privileges may be added, changed or removed depending on the needs of the Arukah Ministry. Any breaking of the rules or backsliding as determined by the Pastoral Staff may result in a removal of privileges and possibly returning to a lower level.
